If you are coming from...

- 1 I-45 North**
(Woodlands, Greenspoint, etc.)
Take I-45 southbound to McKinney exit. Proceed eastbound on McKinney to LaBranch. Turn south on La Branch.
- 2 Hardy Toll Road**
Proceed to Hardy Street exit and continue south to La Branch. Continue southbound to La Branch.
- 3 US 59 North**
(Kingwood, Humble, etc.)
Take Highway 59 southbound to Downtown exit ramp. Proceed south on Hamilton to Congress. Turn west on Congress to La Branch. Turn south on La Branch.
- 4 I-10 West**
(Katy and other points west of downtown)
Take the Smith Street exit. Proceed south to Clay. Turn east on Clay.
- 5 I-45 South**
(Galveston, Alameda Mall, Pasadena areas, etc.)
Proceed north to the Downtown/Scott exit. Continue on the elevated portion to Pease or to St. Joseph, then north on Austin towards arena.
- 6 Highway 288**
Take the Chenevert/Downtown exit. Proceed north on Chenevert
OR
Take the Polk Street exit and proceed west.
- 7 Allen Parkway**
Proceed eastbound on Allen Parkway to Dallas. Continue east on Dallas.
- 8 US 59 South**
(From Sugarland, Bellaire, etc.)
Take the Polk Street/Downtown exit. Proceed westbound on Polk.
- 9 Memorial Drive**
Go east on Memorial Drive to Texas. Continue eastbound to Smith. Proceed south on Smith to Dallas.
- 10 I-10 East**
(Baytown, etc.)
Take I-10E westbound to San Jacinto/Main exit. Take exit to San Jacinto and then to Fannin. Continue south on Fannin.

It is highly recommended that whatever the area of downtown you are entering from, to park in that area of Toyota Center (e.g., if you are entering downtown from the north, park north of Toyota Center). To maximize traffic flow, we recommend parking in the numerous surface lots located within a five-block area of Toyota Center.

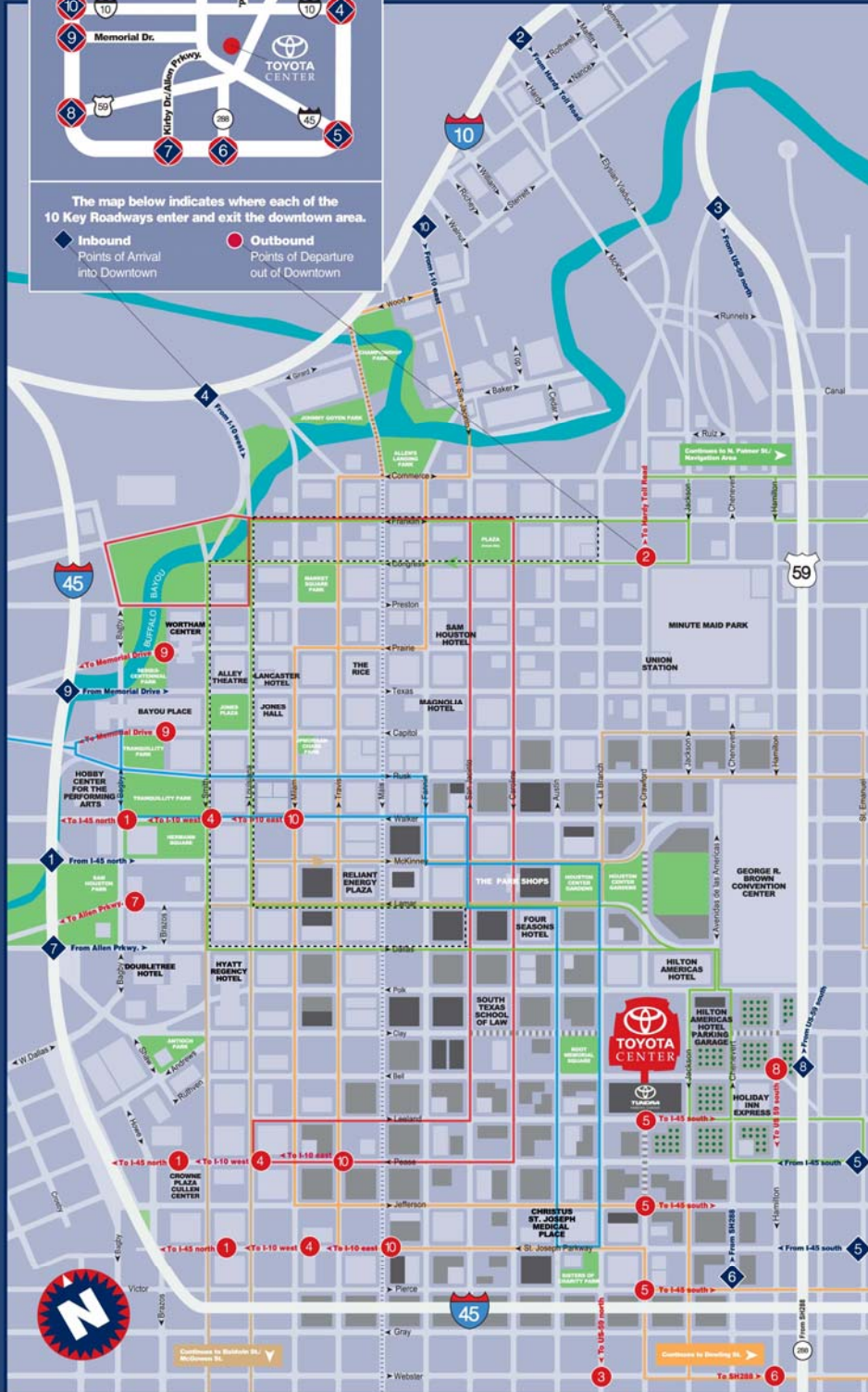
If You're Heading Outbound

If you are departing to...

- 1 I-45 North**
(Woodlands, Greenspoint, etc.)
You can access I-45N by using Walker, Pease, St. Joseph or Travis. Entrance ramp is at Walker.
- 2 Hardy Toll Road**
Take Crawford north to Hardy/Elysian.
- 3 US 59 North**
(Kingwood, Humble, etc.)
Take La Branch southbound to McGowan. Turn east on McGowan and proceed onto US-59N entrance ramp.
- 4 I-10 West**
(Katy and other points west of downtown)
You can access I-10W by using Walker, Pease or St. Joseph to I-45N, then exit to I-10W.
- 5 I-45 South**
(Galveston, Alameda Mall, Pasadena areas, etc.)
Take Jefferson, Leeland or Pierce.
- 6 Highway 288**
Take Hamilton south. Take Jackson or Caroline east to Webster and proceed east on Webster to 288-SR.
- 7 Allen Parkway**
Take Lamar westbound to Allen Parkway.
- 8 US 59 South**
(Sugarland, Bellaire, etc.)

Take Capital or Prairie west to Memorial.

PERFORMANCE RULES & GUIDELINES

As with all performances, remember the following:

1. Check In will NOT begin until the specified time on the permission slip or later; Never Earlier. If you are going to be late you need to contact the Co-Director in charge of your squad. If you are **more than 15 minutes** late, you will not be able to perform.
2. Prior to check in, please make sure you have used the restroom, as some performances do not begin for 1-2 hours after check in and restrooms are not always available.
3. Arrive in FULL uniform or You WILL NOT be able to perform.
4. Officers must wear their bars to be considered an officer, which means that if they forget to wear them, they are out of FULL Uniform and Rule #3 will apply.
5. There is absolutely NO Eating or Drinking in any of the Starlette Uniform(s).
6. Always wear your Performance T-Shirt as a cover up when you are not performing.
7. You must stay at least through the majority of the performance and remain in full uniform to receive a merit. Once we have performed and you are released to your parent/s, If you plan on staying for the remainder of the event, you **MUST COMPLETELY** change out of your Starlette Uniform, into your own clothing.
8. Directors / Officers will not have extra items of the uniform ready for you in case you forget something. It is YOUR responsibility to be in Full Uniform upon arrival/check in.
9. No Cell Phones, MP3 Players, iPods, Etc. Items will be taken and returned to your parents upon check out. Demerits will apply.
10. Respect all Directors, Co-Directors, Parents & Starlettes at all time.
11. No Fighting, Drugs, Weapons, Foul Language or Wondering Off.
12. Please remember that demerits will apply for any violations to the Green Starlette Rules at any time you are signed in with the Green Starlettes.
13. Please make sure that you are in full compliance with all the Green Starlette Rules. If you violate any of the above rules, your parents can be called, you can be asked to leave the event and/or you will have to sit out the performance – **Director in Charge's Discretion.**

**RELEASE AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT
(HOUSTON AEROS)**

I, the undersigned, wish to participate or have my child or ward participate (any such participant being referred to herein as the "Participant") in the Houston Aeros Pre-Game, Intermission, Post-Games or Street Fleet (street hockey) Events (the "Activity"). I understand that there is a risk that the Participant will be injured during the Activity, and I wish for the Participant to participate in the Activity despite the risk involved.

As consideration for the Participant being allowed to participate in the Activity, I, for myself, the Participant (if not myself), and each of our respective successors, administrators, heirs and assigns, hereby **RELEASE, ACQUIT, AND FOREVER DISCHARGE** Minnesota Wild; Aeros Hockey Club; Minnesota Sports & Entertainment; LLC, a Minnesota limited liability company; LLA Sports, Inc.; a Delaware corporation; Wincrest Ventures, L.C.; Clutch City Sports & Entertainment; L.P., a Texas limited partnership; Alexander Tara; L.L.C.; a Texas limited liability company; Houston Sports Authority; The American Hockey League and all of its member teams and operators; the owner(s) and operator(s) of the venue(s) where the Activity is to be held; the other participants in the Activity; and all of the respective past, present and future officers, directors, attorneys, insurers, agents, servants, suppliers, dealers, representatives, employees, coaches, trainers, affiliates, subsidiaries, partners, predecessors and successors in interest, and assigns of the foregoing (collectively referred to herein as the "Released Parties") from all past, present and future claims arising out of and accruing to the Participant for or in any way connected with any damages sustained by the Participant before, during or after, or as a result of, or in any way connected with, the Activity, including actual or punitive damages for personal injury, dismemberment or death sustained in the Participant's participation in the Activity, and all results thereof, past, present and future, known and to become known, accrued and to accrue, and **INCLUDING ANY CLAIMS OF THE RELEASED PARTIES' NEGLIGENCE, GROSS NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR WILLFUL CONDUCT (REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE RELEASED PARTIES ARE SOLELY, JOINTLY, OR CONCURRENTLY NEGLIGENT OR OTHERWISE AT FAULT).**

As a further inducement to the Released Parties, I, for myself, the Participant (if not myself), and each of our respective successors, administrators, heirs and assigns, have agreed to and do hereby **INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD HARMLESS** each and all of the Released Parties from any and all past, present and future claims, demands, actions and causes of action, of whatsoever nature or character, **INCLUDING CLAIMS OF THE RELEASED PARTIES' NEGLIGENCE, GROSS NEGLIGENCE, STRICT LIABILITY OR WILLFUL CONDUCT (REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE RELEASED PARTIES ARE SOLELY, JOINTLY, OR CONCURRENTLY NEGLIGENT OR OTHERWISE AT FAULT)**, which may hereafter be asserted by any person, firm or entity whomsoever, arising out of and accruing to the Participant for or in any way connected with any damages sustained by the Participant before, during or after, or as a result of, or in any way connected with, the Activity, including actual or punitive damages for personal injury, dismemberment or death sustained in the Participant's participation in the Activity, and all results thereof, past, present and future, known and to become known, accrued and to accrue. This obligation to indemnify and hold harmless specifically includes, but is not limited to, any claims for medical bills, doctors' bills, hospitalization, nurses' bills, drugs, therapy, administration, and other expenses, including judgment liens, hospitalization liens, attorneys' fees, and any other form of intervention or lien, or any other expenses incurred by the Participant which are in any way related to the Activity.

As a further inducement to the Released Parties, I hereby represent and warrant to the Released Parties that:

- (1) I thoroughly and completely understand that this is a complete and final release and indemnity agreement concerning any claim, demand, or cause of action which I or the Participant (if not myself) may have against the Released Parties related to the Activity;
- (2) I am entering into this Release and Indemnity Agreement (the "Agreement") freely and voluntarily;
- (3) No representations, promises or statements made by any agent, attorney or other representative of the Released Parties have influenced me in causing me to sign this Agreement;
- (4) The Participant has adequate medical insurance provided by parties other than the Released Parties covering the possible injuries to the Participant that may occur as a result of his or her participation in the Activity; and
- (5) The Participant does not have any physical condition or illness that would be aggravated by participation in the Activity or that would make participation in the Activity medically inadvisable.

I grant to the Released Parties, with no obligation to compensate me, the Participant (if not myself), or any other person in any way, the right at any time to publish, reproduce, modify, display, distribute, or otherwise use, commercially or otherwise, in any media now existing or later developed, any photographs, videotapes, motion pictures, recordings, or other record of the Participant's performance(s) during the Activity.

I agree that any dispute ("Dispute") arising out of or related to this Agreement, the relationship of me, the Participant and the Released Parties under this Agreement and/or the Participant's participation in the Activity will be settled by binding arbitration conducted in Houston, Texas in accordance with the then current Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association and the procedures set forth in this paragraph. I agree that if I seek arbitration due to a Dispute, I shall request such arbitration in writing by delivering a clear statement of the Dispute in writing to the opposing party, and if another party seeks arbitration, such party shall deliver a written request for arbitration to me.

The arbitration shall be conducted by a single arbitrator to be appointed upon the mutual consent of me and the opposing party. In the event that the opposing party and I are unable to agree on a single arbitrator within twenty (20) days after the written request for arbitration was delivered, then either party may request the appointment of an arbitrator by the Administrative Judge of the Harris County, Texas District Court (the "Administrative Judge"). In the event of the failure, refusal or inability of the Administrative Judge to appoint an arbitrator in the next ten (10)-day period, the party seeking the arbitration shall make the parties' request for appointment of an arbitrator, and furnish a copy of the description of the Dispute and any response, to the American Arbitration Association in Houston, Texas. Any arbitrator shall be unaffiliated with me and the opposing party and shall be a resident of Houston, Texas. No arbitrator shall be employed by me or the opposing party has any financial dependence upon me or the opposing party or has any financial interest in the Dispute. The arbitrator shall not have the authority, power or right to alter, change, amend, modify, waive, add to or delete from the provisions of this Agreement. The prevailing party in such arbitration shall be entitled to recover such party's costs and attorneys' fees related to the arbitration from the non-prevailing party, and the costs and expenses of the arbitrator shall be paid for by the non-prevailing party in the arbitration.

I understand that in allowing the Participant to participate in the Activity the Released Parties are relying on the representations and warranties I have made herein. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Texas (without regard to conflict-of-laws principles). If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, that holding shall be without effect upon the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this Agreement.
