**Check In Time:** Sign in at 11:00 am – Parade begins at 2:00 pm.  
(Please note these times are required by the parade committee; not the Starlettes)

**Check Out Time:** Once the Parade has finished – Parents may want to park at Sign Out Point and watch the parade towards the end of the route.

**Wear:** Full Performance Uniform, Officer Bars, Pom Poms, Dance Bag & Permission Slip

**Bring:** Sack Lunch, Water / Drink, Blanket to sit on the ground w/o ruining uniform.

## Parade Rules:

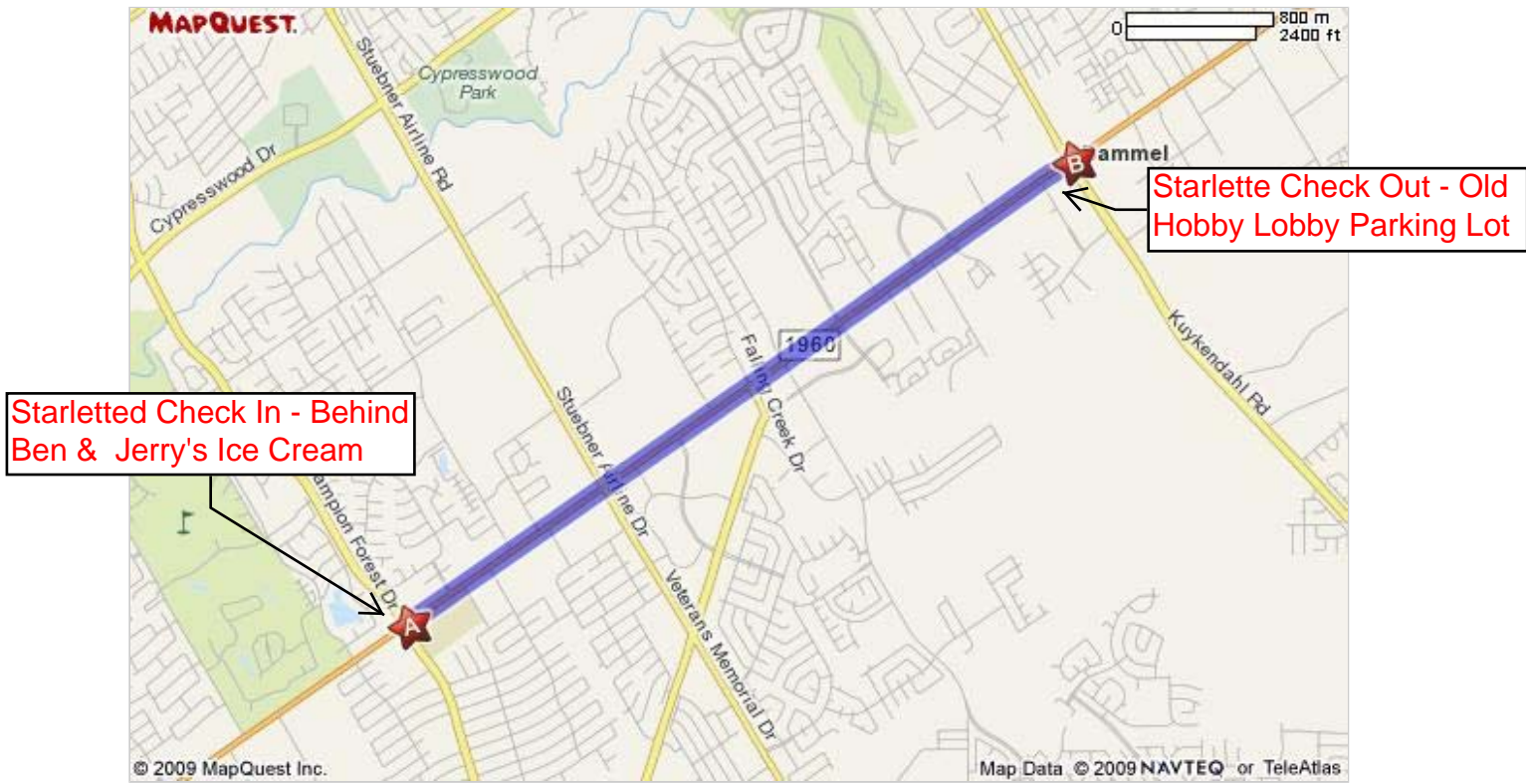
- 1) Starlettes & Directors are the only authorized participants for the parade; however, if your Starlette has a physical concern, then we REQUIRE you to walk with the group.
- 2) Any Missing Items or Variations from the Uniform and/or Tardiness to the parade lineup will result in inability to participate.
- 3) The parade will be held RAIN OR SHINE.
- 4) Please understand that parades are usually NEVER on time and chaos is to be expected. They are sometimes chaotic, but always a lot of FUN.
- 5) We request that all parents stay and watch the parade, somewhere near The OLD Hobby Lobby. Once the Starlettes have passed you, please start walking towards The Old Hobby Lobby, as your daughter will be released as soon as we are finished in the Old Hobby Lobby Parking Lot, NOT when the parade is over.

## PERFORMANCE RULES & GUIDELINES

As with all performances, remember the following:

1. Check In will NOT begin until the specified time on the permission slip or later; Never Earlier. If you are going to be late you need to contact the Co-Director in charge of your squad. If you are **more than 15 minutes** late, you will not be able to perform.
2. Prior to check in, please make sure you have used the restroom, as some performances do not begin for 1-2 hours after check in and restrooms are not always available.
3. Arrive in FULL uniform or You WILL NOT be able to perform.
4. Officers must wear their bars to be considered an officer, which means that if they forget to wear them, they are out of FULL Uniform and Rule #3 will apply.
5. There is absolutely NO Eating or Drinking in any of the Starlette Uniform(s).
6. Always wear your Performance T-Shirt as a cover up when you are not performing.
7. You must stay at least through the majority of the performance and remain in full uniform to receive a merit. Once we have performed and you are released to your parent/s, If you plan on staying for the remainder of the event, you **MUST COMPLETELY** change out of your Starlette Uniform, into your own clothing.
8. Directors / Officers will not have extra items of the uniform ready for you in case you forget something. It is YOUR responsibility to be in Full Uniform upon arrival/check in.
9. No Cell Phones, MP3 Players, iPods, Etc. Items will be taken and returned to your parents upon check out. Demerits will apply.
10. Respect all Directors, Co-Directors, Parents & Starlettes at all time.
11. No Fighting, Drugs, Weapons, Foul Language or Wondering Off.
12. Please remember that demerits will apply for any violations to the Green Starlette Rules at any time you are signed in with the Green Starlettes.
13. Please make sure that you are in full compliance with all the Green Starlette Rules. If you violate any of the above rules, your parents can be called, you can be asked to leave the event and/or you will have to sit out the performance – **Director in Charge's Discretion.**
